Guidance on the compilation of safety data sheets (SDS's)

This is to confirm that all products currently supplied by WD-40 Company are classified and labelled according to Regulation (EC) No. 1272/2008 (CLP).

Directive 94/62/EC on Packaging and Packaging Waste (as amended up to Commission Directive 2018/852 of 30 May 2018)

With reference to Article 11 of Directive 94/62/EC, concentration levels of heavy metals present in packaging: These regulations require that packaging and packaging components meet certain essential requirements, including levels of heavy metals (cadmium, chromium VI, lead and mercury).

Whilst lubricants, greases and detergents are not packaging components in the context of this legislation, we can confirm that these four heavy metals are not intentionally added to products manufactured by WD-40 Company. Although, it is possible that trace quantities of these components may be present in our raw materials, we would expect that the total level of cadmium, chromium VI, lead and mercury would be within the requirements of this regulation.

Carcinogenic, Mutagenic, or Reprotoxic (CMR) Substances
